2011 Eagle Scout Scholarship Program

The Brevard Chapter, Florida Society of the Sons of the American Revolution announces its participation in the *2011 Arthur M. & Berdena King Eagle Scout Scholarship Program*.

The chapter program is open to all Eagle Scouts who are currently registered in an active Brevard County unit and have not reached their 19th birthday during 2011. The year that Eagle was awarded is not restricted and college plans do not need to be completed in order to receive the cash scholarship. Eagle Scouts may apply more than one year if they meet the age and other requirements.

Three cash scholarship awards are given: As the Chapter First Place winner - \$100; Runner-up - \$50; 2nd runner-up - \$25. Each entrant receives a patch and the First Place winner also receives a medal. The Chapter First Place winner is automatically entered in the Florida State competition for awards of \$1,000, \$500, and \$250; the State First Place winner is automatically entered in the National competition for awards of \$8,000, \$4,000, and \$2,000.

The Rules established by the National and State Societies, Sons of the American Revolution shall apply and the decision of the judges is final. **All chapter entries must be postmarked no later than December 16, 2011.** Completed applications should be mailed to:
