

History Moment – Compatriot Doug Bisset presented an early history of the Navy "Sloop Providence". This ship was 60' long, had a beam width of 20', carried a crew of 80, had 10 4-pound canons and 14 swivel guns. It sailed from 1775 to August 1779. On 14 August 1779 she was destroyed by her crew to prevent her from being taken over by the British during the Penobscot Expedition. Other Continental ships saw the same fate on the Penobscot River.

#### LNB MONUMENT IS MOVING

Plans are underway to move the LNB Monument from its current location at the VMC to the Plaza adjacent to the SAR/DAR Monument which is in the center of the Plaza Pentagon. Compatriot Ray Norman brought a motion to the floor at the September 2019 Meeting. At the current location less than 5% of museum visitors see the monument. The move is scheduled to be complete in 2020. A pad has been poured by Lockheed Martin volunteers. The sign has been placed in the Plaza adjacent to the new pad. The granite pieces are bonded together and to the concrete base. Currently looking at ways to safely relocate the granite pieces.
